ACJ321: countdown complete

Airbus has secured the first order for its ACJ321, expanding its corporate jet range across the entire A320 family.

Switzerland-based charter group Comlux ordered the aircraft, which it plans to receive in 2014. The company already operates the

ACJ318, ACJ319 and ACJ320, and will be the first to have the entire family in its fleet.

"Airbus's ACJ321 will enable us to offer our passengers even more of the comfort and space that are the hallmarks of the Airbus corporate jet family," said Comlux CEO Richard Gaona.

The Comlux ACJ321 will be outfitted by Comlux America, and powered by CFM International CFM56-5B engines. It will be delivered in 2013, and enter into service the next year, said Gaona.
