

Comlux The Aviation GROUP “SPACE-SHUTTLE”

Comlux has started to operate its 4th Airbus ACJ Family aircraft, becoming the Premier Airbus VIP aircraft operator worldwide. The brand new Airbus ACJ, completed by the Airbus Corporate Jet Centre in Toulouse (in which Comlux is shareholder) and registered in Malta under Comlux European AOC, is operated by Comlux Malta on a fully private basis from Madrid. Stephen Laven, CEO of Fly Comlux division says, “This additional aircraft, joining our VIP fleet, again demonstrates our strong aircraft management skills and the quality of our VIP operations. Thanks to our Group synergies, the new structure that we put in place in Malta last year is developing very quickly.

It allows us to fly freely between all EU member states and to offer our customers seamless convenience and comfort, may they fly commercially or privately.” “Due to the ultra-modern connectivity and entertainment systems installed in the cabin, the aircraft has received the nickname of “space-shuttle”! To allow a smooth and trouble-free operation of all the cabin features, our flight attendants have followed a special training at the Airbus Training Center in Toulouse”, says Angie Bhorania, Chief Cabin Attendant Comlux. Today, Comlux VIP fleet comprises 15 aircraft: 2 Airbus ACJ, 2 A318 Elite, 3 Bombardier Global Express (including 2 XRS), 2 Global 5000, 2 Challenger 605, 2 Challenger 850, 1 Falcon 2000 and 1 Hawker 850. This includes 3 aircraft managed fully privately (1 Airbus ACJ, 1 Global 5000, 1 Challenger 605).
